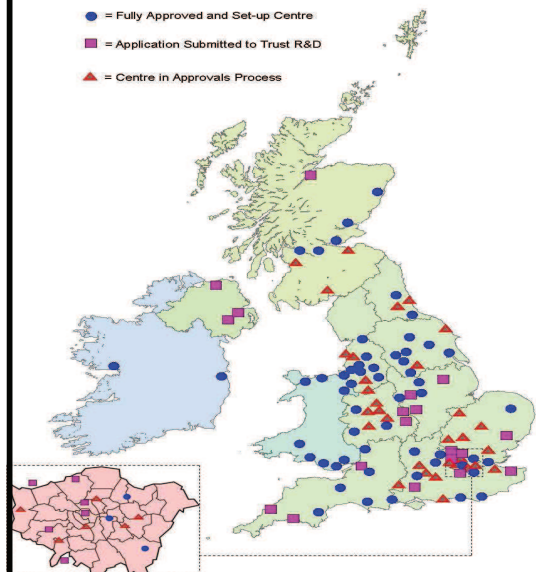


Serious Adverse Events

BADBIR Finance Planning

BADBIR make a payment of £120 per registration and £30 for each follow-up that is entered on the database. The table below makes indicates how much money this equates to if **8 patients per month** are registered from November 2009 through to the end of recruitment in July 2013.

Payments are made at the end of each data entry period which run from 1st February to 31st July and 1st August to 31st January each year.

Registering 8 patients a month means a total payment of up to **£50,880** through to the end of the study follow-up period in July 2017 (this assumes that once a patient is registered all 8 of their follow-ups are completed). **These 8 patients can be registered in either of the biologic or conventional systemic cohorts.**
