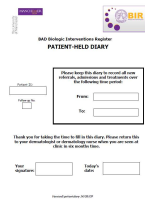
New Recruiters

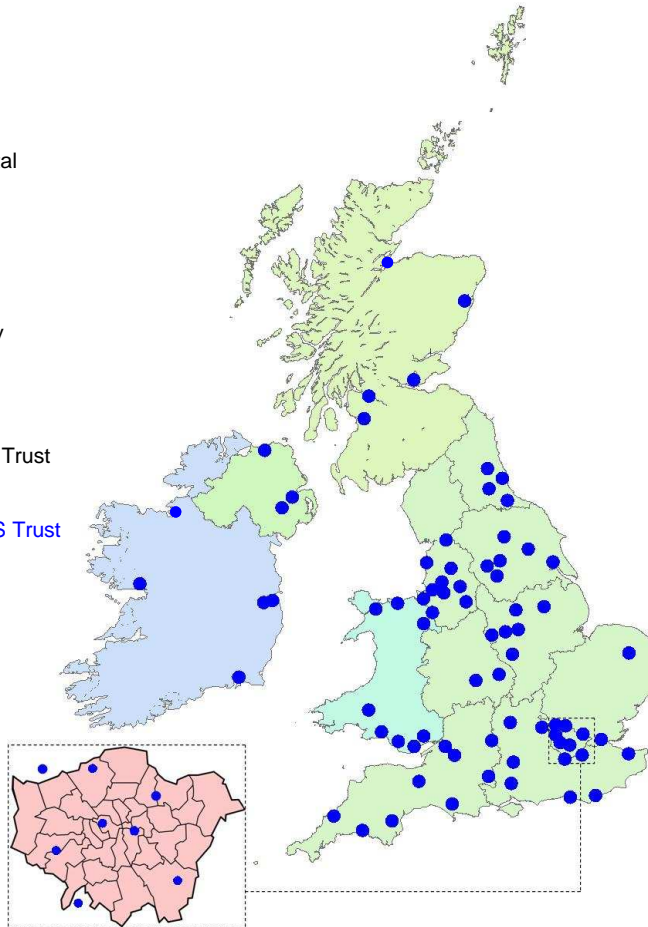
