Patient Management

There is a new section on the database that produces a summary of all the information provided on any patient that your centre has recruited to BADBIR. To reach this, once you have selected a record from the 'View All Patients' list, follow the link to 'Printable Summary Sheet' from the left hand menu.


This will bring up an A4 summary that will include:

- Demographic details
- PASI over time
- Current biologic therapy
- Last recorded weight
- All previous treatments
- All UV therapy

### Data Queries

You may have noticed a new symbol appearing next to the names of some of the records on the 'View All Patients' list. This  icon indicates that there is an outstanding data query for this particular patient. Details of this can be seen by clicking into their summary page and viewing the information at the bottom of the page. If the response to the requested information is available, then this can also be entered here. Once final tweaks have been made to this system we will place further guidance and training materials online.

### Interactive Training Videos

#### Tutorial

At the bottom of every data entry page on the BADBIR database there is now an interactive training session available. You can click the tutorial button to begin and the session will open in a new window.

This will provide a run through of best practice data entry for that page with multiple scenarios provided where appropriate.

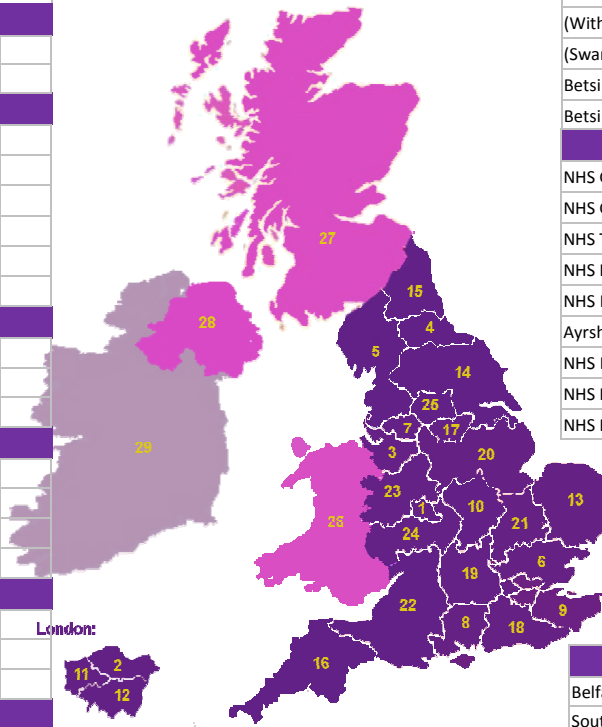
