Entering Changes to a Drug Dose at Follow-up

When the dose or frequency of a patient's biologic or conventional treatment changes, this will need to be recorded on the database as part of the follow-up data entry. To do this, enter a stop date for the original drug information using the **date that the dose changed**. Next enter a new drug also using the date of when the dose changed. Repeat this until all the doses for the follow-up period have been captured. For example:





