


Two-Factor Authentication

For added security, two-factor authentication is required.

Once you have logged into your account, you will be brought to the two-factor authentication page. Here, you can choose to authenticate your account via email or authenticator app.


This involves entering a 6-digit passcode.





Consent Form Page

The consent form page is now separate from the demographics page. Any consent forms can be uploaded onto the 'manage consent forms' section.






Click to Copy Function

The 'click to copy' button visible where dates can be entered (e.g. under the clinic visit date). A green tick will appear in the box if the copy action is successful.

The date can then be inserted using the 'paste' button next to the 'copy' button.

Your browser may ask for permission before pasting.






Methotrexate Titration Function

On the conventional therapy page, the 'titration' button can be found next to the drug entry. and can be used when the patient is titrating through drug doses.



Using this function automatically enters stop reason as 'titration'. On the same page, you can create a new Methotrexate entry by entering the start date, dose and frequency.






Concomitant Therapy Search Function

Previous concomitant medications that have been stopped can now be searched for. On the concomitant therapy page, click the 'Check existing drug entries' tab (below the concomitant therapy table) to show all concomitant therapies the patient has received.

The search box can be used to help find any specific therapies by the drug name.






Home Page Statistics

Your centre home page now contains statistic graphs.

These show the number of:

- Follow-ups entered;
- The data query activity.

The graphs cover the number completed over the past 5 days.









PASI and DLQI Charts

These charts show the PASI/DLQI scores entered in the current cohort. The PASI chart can be found on the disease severity page and the DLQI chart on the DLQI page.

Hovering over the dots on the graph shows the date and score of the PASI/DLQI.







Entering Score-Only DLQIs

DLQIs with only the score (no breakdown available) can now be entered.

This can be done by clicking 'enter score manually' at the bottom of the DLQI page and clicking the 'clear all answers' button to mark the answers to the questions as 'missing'. The score can then be entered with the date and the DLQI can be saved.




Patient Summary/History Page Print

Print toggles are now available on the Patient Summary and Patient History pages. Switching off a toggle will exclude that section from the print preview.

This feature allows you to print only the information you need, rather than the full page.

Print toggles work when printing to PDF as well as when printing on paper.

Feedback on any issues identified on the new database can be provided via the 'Report an Issue' button. This button can be found on the top right corner of the screen, next to the 'Show sensitive data' button.
